1. Data Controller

Personal data is processed by:

IMEC acts as coordinator of the EuroCDP and may process personal data together with other EuroCDP consortium partners involved in programme implementation.

2. Purpose of Processing

Personal data of Experts is processed for the following purposes:

- Management of the EuroCDP expert pool and onboarding
- Organisation and implementation of programme activities and assignments
- Communication related to EuroCDP activities or activities in which EuroCDP is involved
- Administration of contracts, reimbursements, and payments
- Compliance with legal, administrative, and reporting obligations (including towards the European Commission and Chips Joint Undertaking)

3. Categories of Personal Data

The following categories of personal data may be processed:

- Identification data (name, surname)

- Contact details (email address, phone number)
- Professional information (CV, expertise, experience)
- Administrative and financial data

4. Legal Basis

Processing is based on:

- Performance of contractual or pre-contractual measures (including the Appointment Letter and assignments)
- Compliance with legal obligations
- Legitimate interests related to the organisation and management of the EuroCDP programme

Specific processing activities (such as the use of images, audio, or video recordings) are subject to the Expert's explicit consent.

5. Data Sharing

Personal data is shared, where necessary, with:

- EuroCDP consortium partners (as part of the joint implementation of the programme)
- Public authorities and funding bodies (including the European Commission and Chips Joint Undertaking), where required
- Service providers supporting programme operations (e.g. IT systems, event organisation, other stakeholders directly involved in EuroCDP)
- Startups and SMEs participating in EuroCDP, where strictly necessary for the implementation of specific activities and limited to the data required to enable the expert's involvement

6. Data Retention

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary:

- For the duration of the Expert's engagement in EuroCDP
- For the period required by applicable legal, financial, and audit obligations

7. Data Subject Rights

Experts have the right to:

- Access their personal data
- Request rectification or erasure
- Restrict or object to processing
- Request data portability, where applicable
